<p>ART & DESIGN: We will continue to practise and develop drawing skills.</p>	<p>ENGLISH: Dreams and Curiosity Writing, spelling and grammar will be linked to quality texts. The first text will be the BFG by Roald Dahl. We will explore the language that Dahl used and the children will write character descriptions, instructions, letters and narrative. Our Guided Reading sessions will also be linked to the BFG. Our next text will be The Tear Thief by Carol Ann Duffy. We will write letters of explanation as well as poems. Grammar and handwriting practice will be ongoing.</p>		<p>DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: <u>Juggling Balls</u> The children will explore and evaluate different juggling balls. The design brief will be to design and make a circus-themed juggling ball.</p>
<p>GEOGRAPHY: This links to our history topic. We will be locating Rome on a map and learning about the countries that the Romans invaded and the reasons for these invasions. We will focus upon Britain and why the Romans came to settle in particular areas.</p>	<p>MATHS: The main areas of maths that we will be focusing on this half term will be: Calculation: Addition and Subtraction; Multiplication and Division. We will continue to practise number facts such as number bonds and times tables.</p>		<p>HISTORY: We will be looking at the history of the Romans in Britain. We will learn about the Roman invasion and what it was like to live in these times. As part of our topic we will research famous leaders (such as Caesar) and their influence during this time.</p>
