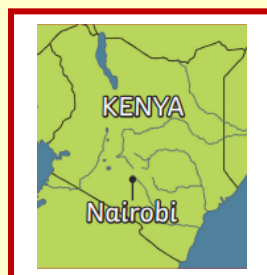




## Year 2 Geography Knowledge Organiser Spring Term 2024
