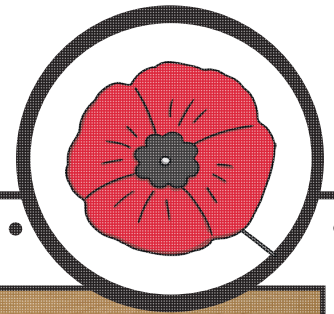
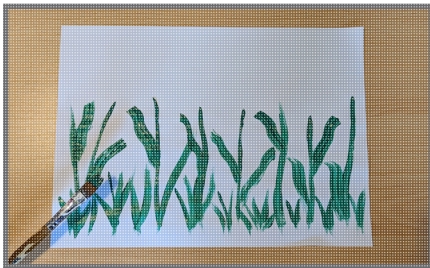


Potato Print Poppies



You will need:

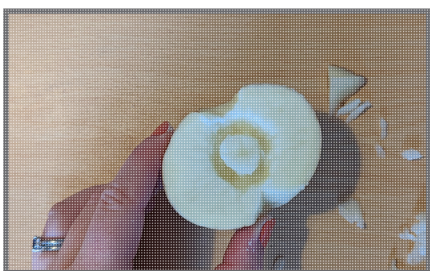
- Black card
- Red, green and black paint
- Paintbrushes
- Potato
- Butter knife
- White card



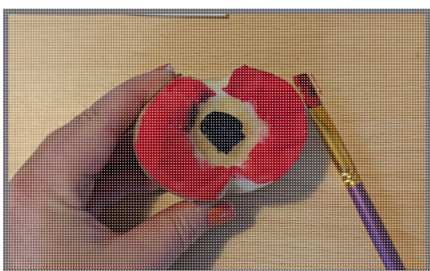
1) First, use the green paint and paintbrush to create the stems and leaves of your poppies onto the white card. We have added in some smaller blades of grass as well.



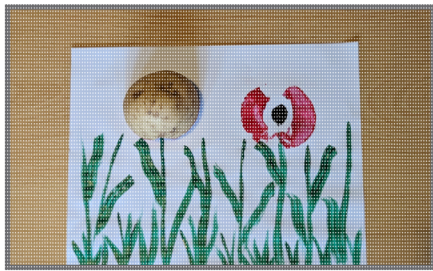
2) Next, with an adult's help, use the butter knife to cut the potato in half.



3) On one half of the potato, cut out a small triangle on each side and a ring in the middle. This will make the shape of the petals and the round pollen in the centre.



4) Paint the petals of your potato print in red and the circle in the middle with the black paint.



5) Gently press the potato print onto the white card, above the long green painted stems.



6) Repeat Steps 4 and 5 until you have a field of poppy prints.
Allow the paint to dry.
