

Remembrance Day Art



This is a collaborative piece of artwork that a group of children have created.

You only need to create one piece of artwork which will represent a quarter of a poppy (just like the photograph).

We look forward to you bringing in your creations to school to share.

You will need:

- Plain paper
- Felt tip pens or colouring pencils

How to do it:

1. Look at the poppies below. Notice how the petals are different shapes and that there are lines – some wiggly, some straight.
2. On a piece of paper, start in any corner by drawing part of the centre of a poppy. (Look at the close detailed pictures below to help you).
3. Gradually work your way out from the centre of the poppy and experiment using wavy/wiggly lines to create the petals.
4. Colour in the outer parts of the poppy – think about the different shades/colours/patterns.

Less is more – this means don't overcomplicate the patterns and colours.

5. Colour the background in blue.
