REMEMBER
There are lots of different spelling strategies:

- *Sound out the word.*
- *Break it down into syllables.*
- *Spell the root word and then add a prefix or suffix.*
- *Say it in a funny way eg par-li-a-ment.*
- *Use a mnemonic, eg big elephants can always understand small elephants.*
- *Look at the word - does it look right?*
