mouth	The part of your body used to eat and taste things.

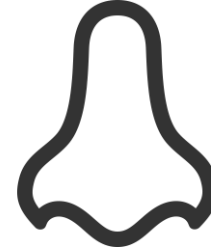

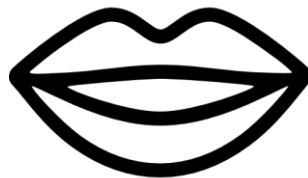
