



**ART & DESIGN:** Drawing Skills  
We will continue to explore what drawing is, what drawing tools are, continuous line drawing, mark-making, techniques used by artists, exploring charcoal and still-life drawings.

**ENGLISH:**  
Reading, writing and spelling linked to quality texts.  
This term our texts will be *A Beautiful Lie* by Irfan Master.  
We will be writing in a variety of different styles, using fiction and non-fiction genres.  
Reading, Spelling, Handwriting skills will be ongoing.

Place Knowledge of Greece and Europe.

**MATHS:**

**HISTORY:** Ancient Greece  
We will learn who ancient Greeks were; about Alexander the Great's empire; daily life; Athens and Sparta; the Trojan war; Greek gods and goddesses; the ancient and modern Olympics.

**LANGUAGES:**

Learning how to describe 'All About Me'

**SCIENCE:**

- explain that unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object;
- identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces;
- recognise that some mechanisms including levers, pulleys and gears allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.

**MUSIC:**  
In Music, the children will learn to sing Leavers' songs. Children will also consider how music makes them feel, linked to emotions.

**PHYSICAL EDUCATION:**  
Starling Class will be learning skills involved in invasion games. These skills will then be used in games such as: Tag Rugby, Football, Netball and Hockey.

**COMPUTING:**
