



ART & DESIGN:

We are going to look at House from Around the World and allow children to work from source materials to develop their creative response skills through drawing and collage.

They will be using;

- Mark making
- Collage
- Line Drawing

ENGLISH:

The children will be spending some time learning stories from a selection of quality texts. We are going to start by reading some stories with a theme of Fictional Worlds and Fantasy.

The Dragon Machine:

Using this text we will create dragon guides & encyclopaedia, letters of advice, dragon machine explanations, shopping lists, descriptions and letters. We will use this text to write our own versions of dragon stories.

Cakes in Space:

Using this text we will create setting & character descriptions, labels, diaries, postcards, captain's logs, instructions and dialogue. We will use this text to write our own versions of fantasy world narratives.

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY:

Year 2 will be making pouches. We will look at how to successfully join a range of materials including sewing.



MATHS:

These are the areas of maths that we will be focussing in this half term.

History:

We will be looking at the lives of a significant individual in the past who contributed to national and international achievements. Linking in with our space theme, we will be studying Neil Armstrong and his influence on the historical landing on the moon!

SCIENCE:

This term we will continue looking at Uses of Every Day Materials. We will start by identifying and sorting different materials and then decide whether they are natural or man-made materials. We will then explore the properties of different materials and consider why they are chosen for particular purposes.

MUSIC:

Year 2 will be learning a song called Tańcymy labada. It is a welcoming Polish circle game with increasingly tricky and hilarious actions.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION:

During our PE lessons, we will be developing the different skills required in athletics.

COMPUTING:

This term we will be learning how to use simple instructions to create an algorithm. We will investigate how the sequence of instructions affects the outcome. We will also be creating some artwork and test it for use in a programme.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION:

This half term we will be learning about what Christians believe about love.

PHSE & SMSC:

This term we will be thinking about the different types of bullying and teasing that people might experience and how we can get help. We are also going to think about our local community and how we can be more involved.
