



ART & DESIGN:

We are going to look at drawing and printing using oil pastels and carbon paper.

1. Thoughtful mark making and diverse mark making
2. Use Carbon paper to sketch shapes
3. Use pastels to add texture
4. Using tracing paper to transfer images

ENGLISH:

The children will be spending some time learning stories from a selection of quality texts. We are going to start by reading some stories with a theme of Kings and Queens.

A Walk in London:

Using this text, we will create a local version of 'A Walk in Wellington', using two styles of writing - recount and information. We will use this text to merge both styles of writing to create a new guide for Wellington.

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY:

Year 2 will be continuing to make pouches. We will look at how to successfully join a range of materials including sewing.

We will also spend time looking at ingredients to make sweet and savoury cakes and biscuits.



MATHS:

These are the areas of maths that we will be focussing in this half term.

History:

Year 2 will be looking at events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally.

We will be looking at the lives of Kings and Queens from the past.
