




<p>ST. JOHN'S CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL</p>	<p>CLASS: Kingfisher, Year 3</p>	<p>TERM: Autumn 1 2021</p>	
<p>ART & DESIGN: In our art and design lessons the children will exploring the inspirational work by Quenton Blake. They will use pencil and water colours techniques.</p>	<p>ENGLISH: Book - 'The First Drawing' by Mordcai Gerstein. The children explore the text, including exploration of the Stone Age and cave paintings. They write diary entries, explore the conventions of speech, create character descriptions and finish by writing their own historical narratives. Book - ' Leon and the Place Between' by Angela McAllister. Throughout the sequence children will explore the author's language and use it as the basis for their own descriptive writing. They will explore the characters' thoughts and emotions and take part in drama activities, leading to writing in role and the creation of dialogue. Using the structure of the original story, children will plan their own version of the story where their own character enters a magical world.</p>	<p>DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: Investigating pneumatics to create and model a moving monster.</p>	
<p>HISTORY: Our topic for this term is all about human development from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We shall be considering the importance of archaeological evidence and how the use of tools changed over thousands of years.</p>	<p>MATHS: These are the areas of maths that we will be focussing in this half term. Number - Place Value Number - Addition and Subtraction.</p>	<p>GEOGRAPHY: We will be looking at land use in urban and rural parts of the UK. Making different maps, learning about map symbols and what they mean. Investigating UK and types of farming on the land.</p>	
	<p>TOPIC/THEME: Stone Age to Iron Age</p> <p>TRIPS/EXPERIENCES: History Day in class Harvest Festival</p>		
<p>LANGUAGES: In French we are going to learn how to count to 10 and to say hello and goodbye.</p>	<p>SCIENCE: Forces and Magnets. We will learn about forces, friction and magnetic attraction, in the context of pushing and pulling. The children will work scientifically and collaboratively to investigate friction, by exploring movement, to identify magnetic materials. We will conduct an investigation, into the strength of different types of magnets, including using their understanding of magnetic attraction to design and create their own magnetic game. They will develop their scientific enquiry skills, making observations, predictions and conclusions.</p>	<p>MUSIC: Year 3 will be learning how to sing in unison and harmony. They will also be preparing songs for Harvest and Christmas.</p>	
<p>PHYSICAL EDUCATION: While the weather still allows, Kingfisher Class will continue their games lessons outside with Mr Parsons. Once it gets too wet and/or cold we will be working indoors with balance work in gymnastics.</p>	<p>COMPUTING: This half-term, we will learn how the internet works and ways in which information is sorted and shared safely.</p>	<p>RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: This term we will be learning why Jesus is important to us and how other faith believers respond to their special places of worship.</p>	<p>PSHE: This term we will be looking at how to keep ourselves and others safe. We shall be reminding ourselves about good personal hygiene, (Covid prevention). We shall also include firework safety, road crossing and being seen in the dark, with the evenings drawing in.</p>
