<p>ART & DESIGN: In our art and design lessons the children will continue exploring the inspirational work by Quenton Blake. They will use pencil and water colours techniques to create articulated beasts using joints and fastenings.</p>	<p>ENGLISH: <u>Book</u> The Tear Thief by Carol Ann Duffy. After exploring the idea that emotions could be matched with jewels, the children read the text 'The Tear Thief' and then explore the imagery within. They create a shared-poem, explore different verb forms used in the text and then write a letter in role using the present perfect form. Following this, the children are presented with a range of scenarios that may cause people to cry. They explore the idea that tears shed for different reasons may/may not be more important than each other. They then receive a letter from The Tear Thief asking for help. The children explore using a range of different grammatical forms of sentence to create an information/persuasive poster before writing a letter to another year group explaining why different tears are more precious than others.</p>		<p>DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: Continuation investigating pneumatics to create and model a moving monster.</p>
<p>HISTORY: Ongoing topic - Our topic for this term is all about human development from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We shall be considering the importance of archaeological evidence and how the use of tools changed over thousands of years.</p>	<p>MATHS: These are the areas of maths that we will be focussing in this half term. Number - addition and subtraction Number - multiplication and division</p>		<p>GEOGRAPHY: Ongoing topic - We will be looking at land use in urban and rural parts of the UK. Making different maps, learning about map symbols and what they mean. Investigating UK and types of farming on the land.</p>

<p>LANGUAGES: In French we are going to learn some body parts, colours and actions.</p>	<p>SCIENCE: Continuation - Forces and Magnets. We will learn about forces, friction and magnetic attraction, in the context of pushing and pulling. The children will work scientifically and collaboratively to investigate friction, by exploring movement, to identify magnetic materials. We will conduct an investigation, into the strength of different types of magnets, including using their understanding of magnetic attraction to design and create their own magnetic game. They will develop their scientific enquiry skills, making observations, predictions and conclusions.</p>		<p>MUSIC: Year 3 will be learning how to sing in unison and harmony. They will also be preparing songs for Christmas with Mr Young from church.</p>
<p>PHYSICAL EDUCATION: While the weather still allows, Kingfisher Class will continue their games lessons outside with Mr Parsons. Once it gets too wet and/or cold we will be working indoors with balance work in gymnastics.</p>	<p>COMPUTING: This half-term, we will learn how the internet works and ways in which information is sorted and shared safely. Weekly i-Pads/android devices for TT RockStars (maths) and Epic reading platforms.</p>	<p>RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: This term we will be learning why Jesus is important to us and how other faith believers respond to their special places of worship.</p>	<p>PSHE: This term we will be looking at how to keep ourselves and others safe. We shall be reminding ourselves about good personal hygiene, (Covid prevention). We shall also include firework safety, road crossing and being seen in the dark, with the evenings drawing in.</p>
