



Year 2 Science Knowledge Organiser Spring Term 2023

This term, in Science, we will learn about a variety of habitats and the plants and animals that live there. We will learn to tell the difference between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. We will make observations of a local habitat and the creatures that live there, investigating conditions in local micro-habitats and how they affect the minibeasts found within them. We will research a range of global habitats and how the living things that live there are suited to their environments, as well as beginning to understand the idea of dependency between plant and animal species.
