**REMEMBER**  
 There are lots of different spelling strategies:

- Sound out the word.
- Break it down into syllables.
- Spell the root word and then add a prefix or suffix.
- Say it in a funny way eg par-li-a-ment.
- Use a mnemonic, eg big elephants can always understand small elephants.
- Look at the word – does it look right?

Use your eyes, your ears and your brain.
